LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1977

A LOCAL LAW OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, REPEALING LOCAL LAW NO.3 OF 1952 WHICH PROVIDED FOR A MANDATORY REFERENDUM ON ANY BOND RESOLUTION AND CAPITAL NOTE RESOLUTION EXCEEDING \$250,000.00.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Local Law No. 3 of 1952 providing for a mandatory referendum on any bond resolution and capital note resolution exceeding \$250,000.00 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions of Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

On roll call, Aldermen Stewart, Haley, Blumette, Griffin and Poitras voted in the affirmative; Alderman Burke voting in the negative; CARRIED.
