LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF 1954

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION AND FIXING THE SALARY OF BILLING MACHINE OPERATOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:


Section 1. Creation of position. There is hereby created in the department of finance the position of Billing Machine Operator who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Common Council, said position to be in the competitive class of the classified Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh.

Section 2. Salary. That the starting salary of such Billing Machine Operator shall be the sum of \$2200 per year to be increased by annual increments of \$100 per year until a maximum salary of \$2500 per year shall be reached and shall be paid at the same time and in the the same manner as other City officials and employees.

Section 3. Time of taking effect: This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Chasolen, Villoni, Laravia, Arbenger and Brewster voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; CARRIED.


