1. Request that the Mayor is authorized to sign a License Agreement with Pine Harbour, Inc to enter City of Plattsburgh property located on Ohio Avenue and Nevada Oval adjacent to the property owned by Pine Harbour, Inc to remove scrub brush, intermittently clear young poplars and raise the canopy of mature trees located on the property paralleling that of Pine Harbour, Inc (hereafter "Tree Line Work"). The intent is to create window views of the lake while avoiding clear cutting and also avoiding removing any trees which may cause erosion of the lake shore area, banks, or impact the structural integrity of the rail lines.

2. Request that the Mayor is authorized to sign the Grant Disbursement Agreement between Dormitory Authority State of New York and the City of Plattsburgh for a grant of \$300,000 for the restoration of the windows in the Historic City Hall Building.

3. Request that the Mayor is authorized to sign a contract for design services on South Peru Street (Sharron-South Catherine) with Greenman Peterson Inc. (GPI) in an amount not to exceed 60,000 to be reimbursed through CHIPs Funding.
4. Request that Contract # 2017-16 “Sodium Thiosulfate for the Water Pollution Control Plant” be awarded to Thatcher Company of NY for the lump sum of \$69,920.
5. Request that Contract # 2018-01 “Liquid Alum for the Water Pollution Control Plant” be awarded to Chemtrade Chemicals U.S. LLC for the amount of \$388/dry ton or \$15,830.40 total.
6. Request that Contract # 2018-03 “City Court Improvements: Holding Cell Wall Protection” be awarded to T&S Builders. The costs will be reimbursed 105% by the New York State Court System.
