LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1959

ENTITLED: LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 80, OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902, AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 38 OF 1949, CREATING THE POSITION OF PARKING METER ATTENDANT.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, IN REGULAR SESSION, DOES HEREBY ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 80 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902, AMENDED BY DOCAL LAW No. 38 OF 1949, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 80. APPOINTMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS. THE PERMANENT POLICE FORCE OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH SHALL CONSIST OF A CHIEF OF POLICE, AND SUCH POLICE CAPTAINS, LIEUTENANTS, SERGEANTS, PATROLMEN, AND PARKING METER ATTENDANTS, AS THE COMMON COUNCIL MAY DEEM NECESSARY. ALL REGULAR POLICE OFFICERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMON COUNCIL. THE MAYOR MAY APPOINT SUCH SPECIAL POLICEMEN AS HE MAY DEEM NECESSARY WHOSE APPOINTMENTS SHALL REMAIN VALID UNTIL REVOKED. THE MAYOR, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE COMMON COUNCIL MAY DESIGNATE ANY REGULAR POLICE OFFICER TO BE ACTING CHIEF OF POLICE AT THE COMPENSATION FIXED FOR THE SAID CHIEF OF POLICE.

SECTION 2. This LAW SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.

ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMEN BRAULT, GIOIOSA, JABAUT, CORODIMAS AND FLYNN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE; NO ONE IN THE NEGATIVE, (ALDERMAN HOLLAI BEING ABSENT) CARRIED.
