AN ACT

In relation to public hearings before the Mayor on Local Laws.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Platts-

Section 1. Whenever a local law after its passage by the Common Council shallbe presented to the Mayor for approval, he shall forthwith fix a date for a public hearing concerning such local law and cause public notice of the time and place of such hearing to be given. Such notice shall be given by publication once in the official newspapers of the City. Such hearing shall be held not earlier than five days after the day of publication of such notice. Such notice shall contain the title of the local law and an explanatory statement concerning the same. The Mayor shall attend at the time and place appointed for such hearing and afford an opportunity for a public hearing concerning such local laws Such hearing may be adjourned from time to time, but an adjournment shall not operate to extend the time of the Mayor to approve such local law or return it to the Common Council with his objections, pursuant to the City Home Rule Law.

Section2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
