

Regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held January 3rd, 1941.

PRESENT: Mayor Bouyea, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Delaney, Golden, Behan and Tyrell.

By Alderman O'Connell; seconded by Alderman Holland:

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1941

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 157 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as last amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1932, providing for proceedings in case of failure to collect tax on warrant.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 157 of the City Charter of Plattsburgh, New York, as last amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1932, be superseded by the following:


SECTION 157. Proceeding in case of failure to collect tax on warrant. On or before the 15th day of November next after any tax or water charge shall have been imposed upon any real estate in the said City of Plattsburgh, New York, the Chamberlain of the said City shall make and deliver to the assessors a transcript of any and all such taxes and water charges which may remain unpaid on the current assessment roll, and it shall be the duty of the assessors, immediately upon the receipt of such transcript to make and deliver to the Chamberlain, a statement containing a brief general description of the location, boundary and estimated quantity of each parcel of land, and in case any of such land shall have been erroneously assessed, then it shall be the duty of said assessors to report the same at once to the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, and the Common Council shall correct such assessment in the manner prescribed by Section 166 of the City Charter and at the same valuation as before, and such corrected assessments and the amount of tax levied upon the lands, shall be valid and effectual for all purposes as though they had originally been correct. The cost of such description, boundary and estimate not exceeding One Dollar (\$1.00) for each parcel shall be audited by the Common Council and paid to the assessor or assessors furnishing the same.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


On roll call Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Delaney, Golden, Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
