

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held January 16, 1942.

PRESENT: Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell.

ABSENT: Mayor Bouyea; Alderman Holland presiding as Acting Mayor.

By Alderman Holland; seconded by Alderman Behan:

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 of 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, being part of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 of the State of New York, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1924, Local Law No. 1 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1926, Local Law No. 2 of 1927, Local Law No. 3 of 1927, Local Law No. 2 of 1930, Local Law No. 1 of 1933, Local Law No. 4 of 1939, Local Law No. 5 of 1939, and Local Law No. 7 of 1939, providing in this instance for the fixing of the salaries of the City Clerk, the Corporation Counsel and the Sealer of Weights and Measures.

BE IT ENACTED BY the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that the provisions of Section 11 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by the aforementioned local laws and with reference to the salaries of the City Officials mentioned therein, that the following shall replace the provisions thereof in relation to the salary of the City Clerk of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, which shall be Thirty-three Hundred Dollars (\$3300.00) per annum beginning January 1st, 1942, Thirteen Hundred and Fifty Dollars of which shall be payable out of the General Fund, Thirteen Hundred and Fifty Dollars of which shall be paid out of the Water Fund, Three Hundred Dollars of which shall be payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department, and Three Hundred Dollars of which shall be payable out of the Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund.


The following shall replace the provisions thereof in relation to the salary of the Corporation Counsel of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, which shall be Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) per annum, beginning January 1st, 1942, Six Hundred Dollars of which shall be payable out of the Water Fund, Three Hundred Dollars of which shall be payable out of the Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund, and One Hundred and Fifty Dollars out of the funds of the Municipal Lighting Department, and Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars of which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The following shall replace the provisions thereof in relation to the salary of the Sealer of Weights and Measures of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, which shall be Three Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$330.00) per annum, beginning January 1st, 1942, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that Section 11 of the City Charter as hereby amended and as amended by later legislative acts and local laws, not inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect.
