LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1946.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11, Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by various local laws to date, in this instance providing for the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increases, for the city officials of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, and adding Section 11-B to the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, providing for the minimum and maximum compensation for employees of said city and fixing the time of taking effect.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended to date is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. Compensation of City Officials.

The members of the Municipal Airport Commission, members of the Board of Health, members of the Board of Education, except the Clerk, members of the Planning Board, members of the Park and Beach Commission, and members of the Plumbing Board shall receive no compensation for their services.

The salary of the Mayor shall be \$2100.00 per year, \$1200.00 of which shall be payable out of the General Fund and \$900.00 of which shall be payable out of the Water Fund.

The salary of each Alderman shall be \$10.00 for each meeting of the Common Council actually attended, but not to exceed the sum of \$500.00 per year, payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the City Judge shall be \$2100.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Clerk of the City Court shall be \$1700.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Acting City Judge shall be \$5.00 for each day that he sits, not to exceed the sum of \$300.00 in any one year, also payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Chief of Police or the Acting Chief of Police shall be \$3,000.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Police Sergeants shall be \$2400.00 per year upon appointment, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of each regular Patrolman shall be as follows:

\$1900.00 for the first year of service, 2000.00 for the second year of service, 2200.00 for the third year and each succeeding year thereafter,

which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Fire Chief shall be \$2650.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the Assistant Fire Chief shall be \$2400.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the regular Firemen shall be as follows:

\$1900.00 for the first year of service, 2000.00 for the second year of service, 2200.00 for the third year and each succeeding year thereafter,

which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the Municipal Civil Service Commissioners shall be \$660.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Commissioner of Public Welfare shall be \$2750.00 per year and shall be payable as follows: 50% out of the Public Welfare Fund, 50% out of the Old Age Assistance Fund.

The salary of the Public Health Officer shall be \$1650.00 per year, \$300.00 of which shall be payable out of the Public Welfare Fund and \$1350.00 payable out of the Board of Health Fund, until such time as the Public Welfare Department of the City of Plattsburgh is integrated with the County of Clinton, and thereafter the entire \$1650.00 shall be payable out of the Board of Health Fund.

The selery of each member of the Board of Assessors shell be \$330.00 per year, except the selery of the Chairman of the Board of Assessors, which shell be \$440.00 per year, which shell be payable out of the General Fund.

The selery of the Corporation Counsel shell be \$2200.00 per year, \$950.00 of which shell be payable out of the General Fund, \$500.00 payable out of the Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund and \$150.00 payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues.

The selary of the Sealer of Weights and Measures shall be \$385.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Superintendent of Public Works shall be \$4,000.00 per year, which sum shall be payable as follows: \$1925.00 out of the Street and Sewer Fund, \$1925.00 payable out of the Water Fund and \$150.00 payable from Municipal Lighting Department Revenues.

The selery of the City Chamberlain, upon appointment, shall be \$2500.00 per year, and the same shall be increased annually at the rate of \$100.00 per year until the maximum salary of \$3,000.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of the City Chamberlain shall receive the maximum compensation of \$3,000.00 per year, said salary to be paid as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues and 5% payable out of the Sewer Maintenance and Operation Fund.

The salary of the City Clerk, upon appointment, shall be 3400.00 per year, the same to be increased at the rate of 100.00 per year, until the maximum salary of 4,000.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of the City Clerk shall receive the maximum compensation of 4,000.00 per year, payable as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues and 8% payable out of Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund.

The salary of the Deputy City Clerk, upon appointment, shall be 2300.00 per year, and the same shall be increased annually at the rate of 100.00 per year, until the maximum salary of 2500.00 is reached, the same to be payable as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues and 8% payable out of the Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund.

Supervisors and Constables shall be entitled to receive the same compensation for their services as corresponding officers in the Towns are entitled to receive for like services.

Inspectors of Election and such other Election Officers as are entitled to be appointed, shall receive compensation which is hereby fixed as follows: Primary Day, \$6.50, each Registration Day, \$6.50, and for General Election Day, \$12.00, all of which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The selery of the Building Inspector, upon appointment, shell be \$2200.00 per year, the same to be increased at the rate of \$100.00 per year, until the maximum of \$2500.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of Building Inspector shall the General Fund.

SECTION 2. Section 11-B of the City Charter is hereby added and reads as follows:

There shall be in the various departments listed below, the following positions which are classified in the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh and the occupants of which shall receive compensation in accordance with these schedules: Column 1 shows the minimum or entrance compensation, Column 2 shows the maximum compensation which may be received, Column 3 shows the rate of yearly increase until the maximum compensation in Column 2 is reached:

Provided however, that notwithstanding, the foregoing schedule, the present Filter Plant Operator shall receive the maximum salary of \$3300.00 per year.

(In the Department of Public Works, skilled laborers shall receive the sum of 77% per hour, semi-skilled laborers shall receive the sum of 7140 per hour and common laborers shall receive the sum of 66¢ per hour.)

In the Fire Department, Call Firemen shall be paid at the rate of 3110.00 per year.

In the Health Department, the Dentist shall receive \$11.00 per clinic when employed.

The salary of the Plumbing Inspector shall be \$330.00 per year upon appointment which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

SECTION 3. PART_TIME EMPLOYMENT.

The Common Council may employ persons on a part-time basis to perform any of the duties of the positions listed in Section 11-B.

SECTION 4. TIME OF TAKING EFFTCT.

This act shall become effective as of January 1st, 1946, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, O'Connell, Giolosa, Demary, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
