LOCAL LAW NO. I OF 1951.

ENTITLED AN ACT establishing the position of Engineering Aide in the Department of Public Works and fixing the compensation thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established in the Department of Public Works the position of Engineering Aide which shall be classified in the competitive class of the Municipal Civil Service. Column 1 herein shows the minimum compensation to be paid to such Engineering Aide-Column 2 shows the maximum compensation to be paid to such Engineering Aide and Column 3 shows the yearly rate of increase until such maximum compensation is reached:

SECTION 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
