LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1959

ENTITLED AN ACT REGULATING WEARING APPAREL UPON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE $^{\rm C}$ ITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. THE WEARING OF BATHING SUITS UPON THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH IS HEREBY PROHIBITED, EXCEPT WHEN SAID BATHING SUIT IS COVERED BY A RAINCOAT, ROBE OR OTHER SUITABLE OUTER COVERING. NOTHING HEREIN SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT THE WEARING OF BATHING SUITS AT THE MUNICIPAL BEACH OR OTHER PLACES DESIGNATED AS BATHING OR SWIMMING PLACES WITHIN THE CITY.

SECTION 2. THE WEARING OF ALL SHORTS UPON THE STREETS AND SIDE-WALKS, PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, EXCEPT THE BERMUDA-TYPE AND JAMAICA-TYPE SHORTS OR TENNIS SHORTS, IS HEREBY PROHIBITED. THE WEARING OF BERMUDA-TYPE AND JAMAICA-TYPE SHORTS OR TENNIS SHORTS IS PERMITTED.

SECTION 3. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS LOCAL LAW SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN (16) YEARS.

SECTION 4. ANY VIOLATION OF THIS LOCAL LAW SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) OR IMPRISONMENT IN THE CLINTON COUNTY JAIL FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE (25)DAYS.

SECTION 5. THIS ACT SHALL BE IN EFFECT ON AND AFTER JUNE 5, 1959, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.
