LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1966

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SUBDIVISION 5, SECTION 150, OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902, IN THIS CASE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES IN FOUR (4) EQUAL INSTALLMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, New York.

SECTION 1: SUBDIVISION 5 OF SECTION 150 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902. IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Taxes shall be collected as follows: One warrant which includes taxes to be levied for all the above purposes shall be issued and the said warrant shall provide for the payment of said taxes in four (4) equal installments; the first installment to be due on March 15th in each year; the second installment to be due on April 15th in each year, the third installment to be due on May 15th in each year and the fourth installment to be due on June 15th in each year, except such dates as fall on Saturday, Sunday or legal holidays, the next business date shall be the due date for that installment. Nothing contained herein however shall prevent the payment by any taxpayer of the total amount of his annual tax and charges after the issuance of said warrant

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect after a Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
