

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held June 23rd, 1944.

PRESENT: Mayor Spear, Aldermen Gervais, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Spinks and Tyrell.

LOCAL LAW NO. 10 OF 1944.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 6 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943 by striking therefrom the minimum and maximum salary together with yearly increment shown under Columns Nos. 1, 2 and 3 respectively, for the position of Sewage Plant Operator and fixing the annual salary of this position to be paid at the rate of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars per annum, and increasing by Seven (7%) percent the annual salary of Sewage Plant Attendant for the duration of World War No. 2 and six months thereafter.

Section 1. Section 6 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943 is hereby amended by striking therefrom the minimum and maximum salary together with the yearly increment shown under Columns Nos. 1, 2 and 3 respectively, for the position of Sewage Plant Operator.

Section 2. Effective June 1, 1944, the annual salary for Sewage Plant Operator is hereby fixed at Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars per annum.


Section 3. Effective June 1, 1944 the annual salary of Sewage Plant Attendant shall be increased by seven (7%) percent, said increase to be regarded as war emergency compensation and to continue in force for the duration of World War No. 2 and for a period of six months thereafter.

Section 4. No part of the additional war emergency compensation received under this act shall be regarded as salary or compensation for any of the purposes of any pension or retirement system in which the officer or employee receiving the same is a member, and the receipt of such additional compensation shall not be deemed to change the basic compensation of any such officer or employee for the purpose of computing a pension, retirement allowance, death benefit, contribution in connection with such membership, or for the purpose of determining any other right or privilege resulting from or appertaining to such membership, or for the purpose of determining the right to any increase of salary or any salary increment. No such additional compensation shall be construed to constitute a promotion or to increase any compensation which a public employee may receive pursuant to section two hundred forty-five of the military law.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect as of June 1, 1944, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Spinks and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative,
