

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held July 10th, 1942.

PRESENT: MAYOR BOUYEA, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell.

LOCAL LAW NO. 11 OF 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 3 of 1928, Local Law No. 2 of 1937, and Local Law No. 6 of 1939, in this instance providing only for an increase in the salary of the Deputy City Clerk from \$2,000.00 per annum to \$2,200.00 per annum, effective January 1st, 1942.


BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 3 of 1928, Local Law No. 2 of 1937, and Local Law No. 6 of 1939, be and the same is hereby further amended, and as so amended to be superseded by the following, insofar as it may affect the provisions thereof relating to the salary of the Deputy City Clerk.

**Section 1. That the** salary of the Deputy City Clerk, effective January 1st, 1942, is hereby fixed at \$2,200.00 per annum, of which sum \$800.00 shall be paid out of the General Fund, as provided for in the General City Budget adopted for the year 1942, and \$1,400.00 of which sum shall be payable out of the Water Fund and or Water Revenues of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, for the year 1942, and for each year thereafter; furthermore that there shall be included in the General Fund to be adopted for the year beginning 1943 and for each year thereafter, a sum sufficient to pay the salary chargeable thereto of the Deputy City Clerk, as hereinbefore provided.

This Local Law shall take effect and be retroactive as of January 1st, 1942.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
