LOCAL LAW NO. 11 of 1970

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 52 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

SECTION I

Section 52 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 52. ORGANIZATION: There shall continue in the City of Plattsburgh, a Department of Public Works. Said Department shall have jurisdiction over all

There shall also be a Superintendent of Streets and Parks who shall perform such duties as may be assigned to him by the Mayor and Common Council."

 $\underline{\text{SECTION II}}$ - This act shall repeal any and all previous local laws inconsistent therewith.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION III}}$ - This act shall take effect after a public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
