LOCAL LAW NO.14 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 158 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 in relation to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

Section 1. Section 158 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 158. Notice of Sale of Land for Unpaid Taxes. Whenever any such tax, water charge or assessment appearing upon the current assessment roll, penalty or interest or any part thereof or either of them, remaining unpaid on the 15th day of November in each year, the Chamberlain shall proceed in accordance with the provisions of this Article to advertise and sell the lands upon which the same was imposed for the payment of such taxes, advertising, penalty or interest or the part remaining unpaid and the expenses of such sale as hereinafter provided shall also be a charge upon said lands.

Section 2. Laws Repealed. Local Law No. 22 of 1942-Local Law No. 1 of 1941- Local Law No. 2 of 1941- and Local Law No. 6 of 1932 are hereby repealed. Section 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect immediately upon public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
