LOCAL LAW NO.16 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 7 of Chapter 269 of the
Laws of 1902 in respect to city officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City
of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:


Section 1. Section 7 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902
in respect to city officers is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. City Officers. The officers of the City shall be
a Mayor, one Alderman from each ward, two Supervisors, a City Clerk,
City Judge, a Chamberlain, Corporation Counsel, a Superintendent of
Public Works, a Chief of Police or Acting Chief of Police, Chief
Engineer of the Fire Department, Superintendent of Water and Sewage,
a Sealer of Weights and Measures, a Constable, nine members of the
Board of Education, nine members of Library Board, a Librarian and
an Assistant Librarian, three members of the Municipal Civil Service
Commission and such other officers as may be provided for elsewhere
in this act and by General Law of State of New York and by special
Statutes or Local Laws.

Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect
after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi
voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED,
