LOCAL LAW NO.17 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Chapter 428 of the Laws of 1912; Local Law No. 8 of 1932; Local Law No. 15 of 1942; Local Law No. 23 of 1942 and Local Law No. 14 of 1948 in relation to appointive city officers and their terms of office.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Chapter 428 of the Laws of 1912; Local Law No. 8 of 1932; Local Law No. 15 of 1942 and Local Law No. 23 of 1942 and Local Law No. 14 of 1948 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 1. Appointive City Officers. The appointive city officers of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, except as otherwise provided by general law, special statute, local laws or this act shall be a City Judge, a Corporation Counsel, a City Clerk, a City Chamberlain, a Superintendent of Public Works, a Chief of Police or Acting Chief of Police, a Chief Engineer of the Fire Department, a Superintendent of Water and Sewage, a Sealer of Weights and Measures, a Constable, nine members of the Board of Education; nine members who shall constitute the Library Board, a Librarian and an Assistant Librarian who shall be appointed by the Library Board, and three members who shall constitute the Municipal Civil Service Commission. The appointment of all the foregoing officers and members of the boards except as specifically stated heretofore shall be made by the Mayor with the approval of the Common Council with the further exception that its approval by the Common Council of the Members of the Board of Education is not mandatory. The officers whose appointments are not otherwise specifically provided for shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Common Council and the approval of all appointments except as herein stated shall mean the concurrence of three aldermen.

Subdivision 2. Term of Office of Appointive City Officers. The term of office of City Judge, Corporation Counsel and Constable shall be for two years, each member of the Board of Education, five years, each member of the Civil Service Commission six years. The terms of office of all other appointive city officers shall be in accordance with the Civil Service Law of the State of New York, the rules and regulations of the New York State Civil Service Commission and the Municipal Civil Service Commission of the City of Plattsburgh.

SECTION 2. LAWS REPEALED. Local Law No. 8 of 1942 is hereby repealed and all other acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT. This act shall take effect immediately after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
