LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1934.

An Act to amend Section 11, Chapter 269 of the Laws of
1902, Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y.,"
as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1924, Local Law No. 1 of 1924,
Local Law No. 4 of 1925, Local Law No. 5 of 1925, and Local Law
No. 3 of 1928, in relation to salaries of certain City officers and
employees, in this instance providing for the reduction of salary
of the Health Officer from \$1500.00 to 1200.00 per annum.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City
of Plattsburgh, New York that Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws
of 1902, Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Plattsburgh,
N.Y.", as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1924, Local Law No. 1 of
1925, Local Law No. 5 of 1925, and Local Law No. 3 of 1928, be and
the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The words and provisions of Section 3 of the
last enacted Local Law, pertaining to the fixing of the salary
of the Public Health Officer, namely Local Law No. 3 of 1928, shall
be and hereby is repealed,

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in place thereof the said
portion of the law, section and Local Law above referred to, shall
read as follows:

Section 3. The Common Council shall fix the salary of the
Public Health Officer of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y., in the sum
not to exceed \$1200.00 per annum, the total amount of which shall
be payable out of the Health Fund.

This Local Law shall become effective on February 16, 1934.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Mc Millan, Raymond, Light,
Frederick, and Shay voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative,
CARRIED.
