## LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1940.

ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 150, PARAGRAPH 3 OF THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, BEING PART OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902 OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES UNDER TWO SEPARATE WARRANTS, AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO.1 OF 1932 AND LOCAL LAW NO.3 of 1935.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 150, Paragraph 3 of the City Charter, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1932 and Local Law No. 3 of 1935, be superceded by the following:

Section 150: Levy of taxes by the Common Council - tax rolls: Paragraph 3. The amount necessary to defray the expenses for the next fiscal year and each year thereafter, as authorized and provided by this Act, such general city taxes shall be divided into six (6) equal parts and six (6) separate warrants shall be issued therefor. The First Warrant to be issued shall include in addition to one-sixth of the general City tax, delinquent water charges and special assessments for the prior year, not heretofore paid, with such fees and/or penalties as may have accrued thereon, together with the proportionate charge for water and sewer rentals as the whole charge therefor may be divided into six (6) equal parts, and such other items as the Common Council may deem best to include. The Second Warrant, and each subsequent Warrant shall be issued not later than the following dates in any calendar year, with the exception that if any of the dates specified fall on a holiday, then the date of issue of the Warrant shall become effective on the day following, which Warrants when authorized to be issued shall provide for the collection of one-sixth (1/6th) of the General City Tax, Water Charges and Sewer Rentals, excepting that taxes to be collected under the First Warrant shall be as hereinbefore provided:

First Warrant February 15th, Second Warrant 15th, April Îhird Warrant 15th, June Fourth Warrant July 15th, Fifth Warrant 15th, August Sixth Warrant 15th, Sept.

Nothing herein contained, however, shall prevent the payment by any taxpayer of the total amount of his annual tax and charges after the issuance of the first warrant.

This Local Law shall take effect January 1st, 1940.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Raymond, Light, Behan and McCready voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative. CARRIED.
