LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1956

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION OF POLICE-WOMAN IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, New York as follows:

SECTION 1: THERE IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE POSITION OF POLICE-WOMAN, WHICH SHALL BE HELD BY A WOMAN, AND SHALL BE IN THE COMPETITIVE CLASS OF THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE.

THE SAID POLICE-WOMAN SHALL HAVE THE SAME RANK AND SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME SALARY AS A PATROLMAN.

SECTION 2. This Act shall become effective after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
