LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1968

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING ARTICLE 5-A AS ADDED TO CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902 BY LOCAL LAW NO. 33 OF 1949 IN THIS INSTANCE PROVIDING THAT THE MANAGER OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT SHALL BE THE MANAGER OF WATER AND SEWAGE, THE PLANT SUPERINTENDENT SHALL BE THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND SEWAGE AND THAT THE ACCOUNTING AND COLLECTION OF WATER RENTALS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND SEWAGE SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK.

SECTION 54 OF THE TITLE 5-A OF THE CITY SECTION 1: CHARTER AS ADDED TO CHAPTER 269 OF LAWS OF 1902 BY LOCAL LAW No. 33 of 1949 is HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

> "Section 54. Organization. The Department of Water and SEWAGE IS HEREBY CONTINUED. SAID DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, OVER ALL WATER MAINS, PIPES AND LINES WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH AND OVER ALL SEWER LINES WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH AND SHALL HAVE EX-CLUSIVE JURISDICTION OVER ALL FACILITIES OF WATER AND SEWAGE WHICH MAY BE ACQUIRED IN THE FUTURE OR ARE NOW IN EXISTANCE. THE MANAGER OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPART-MENT SHALL ACT AS MANAGER OF THE WATER AND SEWAGE DEPART-MENT AND THE PLANT SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHT-ING DEPARTMENT SHALL ACT AS SUPERINTENDENT, AND THE ACCOUNTANT FOR THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT SHALL BE THE ACCOUNTANT FOR THE WATER DEPARTMENT. IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES HEREIN ABOVE PRESCRIBED, ALL WATER RENTALS HERETOFORE COLLECTED BY THE CITY CHAMBERLAIN SHALL NOW BE COLLECTED BY THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT BUT THE SAID WATER RENTALS SHALL BE KEPT SEPARATE FROM ANY MUNICIPAL LIGHTING FUNDS AND SHALL BE RECORDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE UNIFORM SYSTEM OF ACCOUNTING AS PRESCRIBED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND BY THE COMPTROLLER OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND DEPOSITED WITH THE CITY CHAMBERLAIN AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW.

SECTION 2: THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR. A.
