LOCAL LAW No. 2 of 1977

AN ACT AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 6 of 1976 ESTABLISHING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION II of Local Law No. 6 of 1976 entitled "An Act establishing residency Requirements for Employees of the City of Plattsburgh, New York" is hereby amended to delete Section II thereof and in lieu thereof to provide as follows:

SECTION II Any such applicant so employed by the City of Plattsburgh shall continue to maintain his residence within the City during the term of his employment and shall forfeit his position if he fails so to do. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to persons employed prior to December 22, 1976."

On roll call, Aldermen Burke, Stewart, Blumette, Griffin and Poitras voted in the affirmative; Alderman Haley voting in the negative; CARRIED
