All Land or Territory located within the Town of Plattsburgh that lies within the Revised City Boundary is hereby annexed to the City of Plattsburgh effective immediately upon filing this local law in the Office of the Secretary of State.
- 2. The zoning and planning permits and approvals heretofore granted by the City of Plattsburgh Zoning Board of Appeals and Planning Board to property, including property located within the Annexed Territory, is hereby authorized, approved and ratified.

SCHEDULE A REVISED CITY BOUNDARY

City of Plattsburgh Charter section C-1-2 A, Boundaries of the city, is amended in part as set forth in the following attached two page description.

(Existing boundary descriptions are shown in regular print, proposed revisions are shown in dark print).
