## LOCAL LAW NO. 22 OF 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 158 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 in relation to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 158 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of the State of New York, for the Year 1902, Entitled an Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1941, be and the same is hereby further amended, and by such amendment to be superseded by the following:

Section 158. Notice of Sale of Land for Unpaid Taxes.

Whenever any such tax, water charge or assessment appearing on the current assessment roll for the year 1942 and each year thereafter, penalty or interest or any part, or either of them, shall remain unpaid on the first day of December, the Chamberlain shall proceed in accordance with the provisions of this Article, to advertise and sell the lands upon which the same was imposed for the payment of such taxes, expenses of such sale as hereinafter prescribed shall also be a charge upon said lands.

This act shall take effect on December 1st, 1942.
