

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of 1927.

A Local Law creating the office of Police Sergeant, fixing the salary and prescribing the duties of such office.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created and shall be in the City of Plattsburgh the office of Police Sergeant.

Section 2. Said officer shall be appointed from the members of the police force and shall hold office as provided by the terms of the City Charter and the Civil Service regulations of said City, and shall receive five dollars (\$5.00) per month more than the patrolman's salary for his service as said officer.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Police Sergeant under the direction of the Chief of Police to attend to such duties, to keep such records and to render such reports as said Chief of Police shall direct, including among others service records and disciplinary records of the patrolmen. He shall also, in the absence or incapacity of the Chief of Police, have all the powers and duties of the Chief of Police.

Section 4. Any provisions of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
