LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1933

ENTITLED AN ACT to provide that an employee of the City of
Plattsburgh, New York, having served in the Competitive Class of
the Municipal Civil Service of said City for an uninterrupted
period of thirty years may, upon proper application made therefor
to the Mayor and Common Council and in their discretion, continue
as an employee on a half time basis and receive from the City one-
half the amount of compensation which such employee had received
when in the employ of the City on a full time basis.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City
of Plattsburgh, New York, that when a person has served in the
Competitive Class of the Classified Municipal Civil Service of
the City of Plattsburgh, New York, for an uninterrupted period
of thirty years, the Mayor and Common Council may, in their
discretion, and upon proper application made therefor, allow
such person to continue as an employee of the City on a half time
basis and receive from said City one-half the amount of compensa-
tion which such employee had received when in the employ of the
City on a full time basis.

On roll call Aldermen Holland, Roach, Raymond, Light, Spear-
man and Shay voted in the affirmative. No one in the negative.
CARRIED.

after public hearing held this 10th day of March 1933.
