LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1956.

ENTITLED a Local Law fixing the salary of the Aldermen of Plattsburgh at \$1200 per year.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Salary of the Aldermen.

The salary of the Aldermen shall be the sum of \$1200 per year effective August 1st, 1956, the same to be paid in the same manner as other City Officials.

Section 2. Laws superseded.


Local Law number 4 of 1955 insofar as it relates to the salary of the Aldermen is hereby superseded.

Section 3. Time of taking effect.

This law shall take effect August 1, 1956, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Brault, Villoni, Jabaut, Corodimas and Flynn voted in the affirmative; Alderman Holland voted in the negative, CARRIED.
