LOCAL LAW NO. 38 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 80 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 ~~as amended by Section 449 of the Laws of 1903~~ as amended by Section 449 of the Laws of 1903 and all acts amendatory thereof and in this instance providing for the appointment of police officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 80 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Section 449 of the laws of 1903 and all acts amendatory thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 80. Appointment of Police Officers. The permanent police force of the City of Plattsburgh shall consist of a Chief of Police and such police captains, lieutenants, sargents and patrolmen as the Common Council may deem necessary. All regular police officers shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Common Council. The Mayor may appoint such special policemen as he may deem necessary whose appointments shall remain valid until revoked. The Mayor, with the consent of the Common Council may designate any regular police officer to be acting Chief of Police at the compensation fixed for the said Chief of Police.

SECTION 2. Laws Repealed. Local Law No. 3 of 1927 and Local Law No. 1 of 1935 and all acts inconsistent with this act shall and are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
