

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held May 2nd, 1947.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyrell, Aldermen Gervais, LeClair, Gioiosa, Demary, Ryan and Gardi.

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1947.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Subdivision 2 of Section 9 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh", fixing the terms of office of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Plattsburgh, for a period of four years.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2 of Section 9 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 2. Terms of elective officers. The term of office for the Mayor and Aldermen in the City of Plattsburgh shall be for four (4) years, commencing January 1st, 1948, and the persons elected to such offices at the general election held November 4th, 1947, shall be elected for such term of office. The terms of office of Supervisors shall be in duration, the same as Supervisors of the Towns of Clinton County.


SECTION 2. After passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, this law shall take effect immediately upon further approval by the affirmative vote of the majority of qualified voters of the said City of Plattsburgh, voting at a Special Election to be held on the 14th day of July, 1947, in the following form:

PROPOSITION NO. 1.

Shall there be approved and adopted in the City of Plattsburgh, Local Law No. 4 of 1947 ~~of 1947~~ amending Subdivision 2 of Section 9 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh", and fixing the terms of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Plattsburgh for a period of four years, as said Local Law was enacted by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh on 1947, and approved by the Mayor on 1947.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, LeClair, Gioiosa, Demary, Ryan and Gardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative,
