LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1950.

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Local Law No. 42 of 1949, in this instance providing for minimum and maximum compensation for the Senior Stenographer and also providing for the establishment of the position of Account Clerk-Typist and fixing the compensation thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-Paragraph 3 of Local Law No. 42 of 1949 relating to the positions in the City Clerk's Office is hereby amended so that the minimum salary appearing in Column 1 for Senior Stenographer shall be Twenty-eight Hundred (\$2800.00) dollars and the maximum salary appearing in Column 2 shall be Thirty-one hundred (\$3100.00) dollars and the rate of increase per year, appearing in Column 3 shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars per year. It being further enacted that the present incumbent of the position of Senior Stenographer shall receive the maximum salary provided for as above, upon this law going into effect.

Section 2. Section 2 of Local Law No. 42 of 1949 is hereby amended by adding to paragraph 2, relating to the positions in the City Chamberlain's Office, the position of Account Clerk-typist so that the minimum salary for such Account Clerk-Typist as in Column 1 shall be Two thousand-five hundred and thirty (\$2,530.00) dollars, the maximum compensation to be Two Thousand-seven hundred and thirty (\$2,730.00) dollars as indicated in Column 2 and the rate of annual increase to be One Hundred (\$100) dollars per year as indicated in Column 3.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1st, 1950, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Demary, Slattery, and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
