LOCAL LAW NO. 4 of 1979

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Local Law No. 12 of 1970 providing for the compensation for Aldermen of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1: COMPENSATION OF ALDERMEN: Section 1 of Local Law No. 12 of 1970 is amended to provide that the salary of an Alderman of the City of Plattsburgh, New York shall be the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) annually, and if appointed Acting Mayor, shall receive an additional \$250.00 annually.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 2}}.$ The provisions of all Local Laws inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby superceded.

SECTION 3: This Local Law shall be in effect on and after January 1, 1980, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
