- C. It shall be unlawful to park on a city street or public parking lot for more than the length of time permitted by the traffic order establishing the zone and shown on signs limiting parking time within such zone. A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), plus a penalty of \$5.00 for each week such fine remains unpaid.
- D. Parking in a no parking zone, restricted area and loading and unloading zones, or parking in a traffic lane, or a violation of §252-6A or §252-6B, shall be punishable by a fine of not less than thirty-five dollars (\$35), nor more than fifty dollars (\$50), plus a penalty of five dollars (\$5) for each week that the fine remains unpaid.
- E. Parking in areas designated for handicapped parking by a person who is not disabled shall be punishable by a fine of not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75) for the first and seventy-five to one hundred fifty dollars for the second offense occurring within a period of two years within the City of Plattsburgh, plus a penalty of five dollars (\$5.00) for each week such fine remains unpaid.
- § 252 -16 Fines and Penalties. A violation of any section of this Chapter, where a fine is not specified for the offense, shall be punishable by a fine by a fine of not less than fifteen dollars, plus a penalty of five dollars (\$5.00) for each week that such fine is unpaid.
