## LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 1944.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend in part Section 3 of Local Law No. 5 of 1942, by striking therefrom the minimum and maximum salaries together with yearly increments shown under Columns 1, 2 and 3, respectively, for the position of Business Manager of the Municipal Lighting Department of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, and fixing the annual salary of this position to be paid at the rate of \$3,500.00 per annum effective May 16, 1944.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that:

Section 1. Section 3 of Local Law No. 5 of 1942 is hereby amended by striking therefrom the minimum and maximum salaries, together with the yearly increments shown under Columns 1, 2 and 3, respectively, for the position of Business Manager of the Municipal Lighting Department of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y.

Section 2. Effective May 16, 1944, the annual salary for the Business Manager of the Municipal Lighting Department is hereby fixed to be paid at the rate of \$3,500.00 per annum, the same to be chargeable to and paid from revenues of the said Municipal Lighting Department.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect as of May 16, 1944, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call Aldermen Gervair, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Spinks and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED. Alderman Gervais excused from voting.
