LOCAL LAW NO. 5 of 1967

By Alderman Sabourin ; seconded by Alderman King

A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION OF BINGO INSPECTOR PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES AND FIXING THE SALARY OF THE POSITION:

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

SECTION 1. Creating of Position: There is hereby created in the City of Plattsburgh, New York, the position of Bingo Inspector, which shall be in the exempt class of the classified Municipal Civil Service.

SECTION 2: Duties: The said Bingo Inspector shall perform such duties as are prescribed by the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, and all other Laws both State and Local or Ordinances applicable thereto.

SECTION 3: Salary: The salary of said Bingo Inspector shall be the sum of \$1300.00 per year payable in weekly installments in the same manner as other City employees.

SECTION 4: Time of Taking Effect: This act shall take effect as of June 1st, 1967, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen King, Sabourin, Coffey and Rougeau voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; (Aldermen Booth and Duken being absent) CARRIED.
