## LOCAL LAW NO. 6 of 1933.

ENTITLED AN ACT to provide for the appointment of a. Plumbing Inspector, the fixing of the term of office and the salary therefor and the placing of the position in the Unclassified Service of the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of the General City Law, there shall be appointed a Plumbing Inspector, whose appointment shall be made by the Board of Health after its determination of the fitness and qualifications of the applicant therefor.

Section 2. The term of office of the Plumbing Inspector shall be for two years and he shall hold office until the appointment of his successor but the term of office shall not continue beyond that of the Mayor, except as in this act provided. He shall receive an annual salary of \$300.00, to be payable out of the General Fund for which due provision shall be made therein beginning with the fiscal year 1934.

Section 3. For the remainder of the current year of 1933, the Common Council is authorized to transfer from the Unestimated Revenues such sum as may be necessary for the payment of the salaries of the members of the Examining Board of Plumbers and the Plumbing Inspector and such other amount as may be necessary for the proper functioning of the said Board.

Section 4. The position of Plumbing Inspector shall be in the Unclassified Service of the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call Aldermen Holland, Roach, Raymond and Shay voted in the affirmative. Aldermen Light and Spearman voting in the negative.

CARRIED.

The foregoing Local Law is hereby approved after Public Hearing held this 14th day of October, 1933.
