LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1944.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 3 of Local Law No. 5
of 1942, fixing the minimum salary for the position of
Lineman at \$2280.00 per annum for the duration of World
War No. 2 and for a period not to exceed six months
thereafter.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of
Plattsburgh, New York.

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Local Law No. 5 of 1942 with respect
to the position of "Lineman" is hereby amended by substituting, for
the duration of World War #2 and for a period not to exceed six
months thereafter, the following rate of pay in place and instead
of the rate of pay indicated therein under Column No. 1; Columns
No. 2 and No. 3 remaining the same.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect as of February 14,
1944, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
