LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1970

ENTITLED AN ACT providing for the compensation,  
rate of increase, and time of taking effect of such increases for  
various City personnel.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council  
of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES INCLUDED IN

THE FOLLOWING CLASSIFICATIONS:

SECTION 1. C. Employees who work in job classifications included in this section shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. LONGEVITY

- (A) Upon anniversary date of completion of five (5) years of continuous employment, employees covered by this agreement shall receive longevity service pay in the form of an hourly increase, which increase shall for each year of employment thereafter be in the aggregate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- (B) Upon the completion of each additional multiple of five (5) years continuous service, the employee shall receive an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in the manner provided in (A) above.
- (C) No employee, who on the effective date of this Local Law, has been receiving a greater amount of longevity pay on the system provided for in Local Law No. 12 of 1968 shall suffer a diminution of pay.

2. RETROACTIVITY.

- (A) Upon this Local Law becoming effective, the wage rates provided in this Section shall be retroactive to January 1, 1970, pursuant to an Employment Agreement dated August 27, 1969, wherever legally permissible.
- (B) The retroactive pay shall be computed and paid on the basis of 35 hours for the classification listed in Subdivision A above, and 40 hours for the classifications in Subdivision B above, for each pay period the employee worked.

SECTION 1. C - Continued.

3. PREMIUM PAY.

Premium pay will be paid to employees covered under and pursuant to the terms of an agreement dated September 29, 1970 between the City of Plattsburgh and Local 788, Council 66, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.

SECTION 2. SUPERSESION.

Provisions of all acts inconsistent with this act or contrary to the agreement between the City of Plattsburgh and A.F.S.C.M.E. Local 788, Council 66, AFL-CIO, dated Sept. 29, 1970 are hereby superseded.


SECTION 3. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT

This act shall be in effect on and after October 22, 1970 after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.


