- 1. City Code Chapter §241-1, Sale of Surplus Property, is hereby repealed.
- 2. A new Chapter §241-1, Sale of Surplus Property, is enacted which reads as follows:

§ 241-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

REAL PROPERTY. Means fee title, easements and other interests in real property that may be granted or conveyed by the owner of the fee title.

REAL PROPERTY TAKEN BY TAX SALE — Any real property within the City of Plattsburgh which, as a result of nonpayment of taxes, has been conveyed indefeasibly to the City of Plattsburgh.

§ 241-2. Sale of real property acquired by tax sale. The Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh may by resolution establish such criterion as it deems in the best interest of the people of the City of Plattsburgh for the disposal of parcels of real property owned by the city as a result of title having been acquired through a tax sale. The Council may make such transfers for consideration or without consideration on such terms as it deems proper.

§ 241-3. Sale of other real property.

- A. The Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh may by resolution establish such criterion as it deems in the best interest of the people of the City of Plattsburgh for the disposal of real property owned by the city. Such resolution shall include the following findings:
- 1) The property is not park, recreation or othe property that is inalienable under the New York Constitution.
- 2) The property is surplus property in that it is not needed for a public purpose, now or in the foreseeable future.
- 3) The consideration to be paid or given by the person acquiring the property is fair and reasonable and the transfer does not constitute an unconstitutional gift of public property. In determining whether the consideration is fair and reasonable, the Common Council may consider the following.
- a. The cost savings the City will realize by not having to maintain the property.
- b. The value of improvements and maintenance to the property made by the person to whom the property is conveyed, or his predecessor in title.
- B. The Council may make such transfers for consideration or without consideration on such terms as it deems proper, only upon a 3/4 majority vote of all of the members of the Common Council.
- 3. The authority to dispose of City owned property under chapter is not exclusive, but in addition to the authority given under state law and other City laws.
