## LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 145a of the City Charter as set forth under Local Law No. 15 of 1948

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 145a of the City Charter, as adopted by Local Law No. 15 of 1948 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 145A Abolishment of Board of Assessors and creation of Commission of Assessment and Taxation; their powers and The Board of Assessors as now constituted in the City of duties. Plattsburgh is hereby abolished. Hereafter, upon the taking effect of this act, there shall be in the City of Plattsburgh, A Commission of Assessment and Taxation consisting of five members. Said Commissioners shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Common Council for a term of five years each except that the first appointments made under this act shall be for one Commissioner appointed for a term of five years; one for a term of four years; one for a term of three years; one for a term of two years and one for a term of one year and upon the expiration of the term of office of a Commissioner, the Mayor with the approval of the Common Council, shall appoint a new Commissioner to hold office for five years. Said Commissioners shall select one of their members

to be Chairman. The said Commission shall perform all the duties required by them by this act in relation to the assessment of property in said City as well as for the purpose of imposing taxes levied by the Board of Supervisors of County of Clinton as those levied by the Common Council of said city to that end they shall possess all the duties and powers and authority of Town Assessors except as modified by this act.

Section 2. Laws Repealed. Section 31 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 and Local Law No. 7 of 1948 are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
