LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 1954.

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION AND FIXING THE SALARY OF DEPUTY CITY COURT CLERK.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Creation of position: There is hereby created the position of Deputy City Court Clerk who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Judge, said position to be in the exempt class of the classified Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh.

Section 2. Salary: That the starting salary of such Deputy City Court Clerk shall be the sum of \$2600 per year, to be increased by annual increments of \$100 per year until the maximum salary of \$2900 per year shall be reached; and shall be paid at the same time and in the same manner as other city officials and employees.

Section 3. Time of taking effect: This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Chasolen, Villoni, Laravia, Arbenger and Brewster voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
