INSPECTOR.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH;
NEW YORK:

SECTION 1. THE SALARY OF THE HOUSING INSPECTOR SHALL BE THE
SUM OF \$3974, ON APPOINTMENT AND SHALL REACH A MAXIMUM OF \$4558,
IN FIVE (5) EQUAL INCREMENTS.


SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER PUBLIC HEARING
AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.
