- 1. Chapter 253 Article 2 is amended to add the following:
 - a. Front Yard. A yard situated between a building on a lot and the street line or, where the lot is unimproved, between the front yard setback line and the street line. Where a lot is a corner lot, the yards on both streets shall be considered front yards.
 - Setback Line A line within the bounds of a lot parallel to a property line at a distance from the respective property line equaling the respective required front, rear or side yard as defined in City Code Chapter 270.
- 2. Chapter 253 Article 6 is amended to add the following:
 - 6.8 Front Yards. In R-1 and R-H districts or OL-P Districts as established under Chapter 270 of the City Code, no motor vehicle shall be parked in the front yard of any lot, except on a paved driveway or an approved, paved parking area.
